

ORDINANCE 0-91-1

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A NUMBERING SYSTEM FOR CITY ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SUPREME COURT OF ARKANSAS ADMINISTRATIVE RULING NO. 73-240; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: In accordance with the Supreme Court of Arkansas Administrative ruling No. 73-240 the City of Arkadelphia, Arkansas, hereby adopts a numbering system for its ordinances and resolutions beginning with the last two digits of the current year and the number assigned to the document beginning with the number one with said documents to be numbered consecutively and with the numbering system to start over each calendar year in accordance with the following examples:

Ordinances: 0-91-1
 0-91-2
Resolutions: R-91-1
 R-91-2


This numbering system shall be preceded by the letter "O" or the letter "R" designating whether the document is an ordinance or a resolution.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3: It is necessary for the City to comply with Administrative Ruling No. 73-240 of the Supreme Court of Arkansas and with the legitimate request of our auditors in order to establish a numbering system for ordinances and resolutions therefore an emergency is declared and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
