

ORDINANCE NO. 0-91-2

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS OVER FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS: Clark County Landfill because of new EPA guidelines has been closed;

WHEREAS: the City of Arkadelphia installed a solid waste compactor station, transfer truck and boxes for transporting Clark County solid waste to the Benton Regional Landfill;

WHEREAS: a second over the highway truck is needed to avoid bottlenecks in the compactor station operation and to avoid unreasonable delays in the dumping of city and county curbside trucks and front end loader trucks;

WHEREAS: the procedure to invite competitive bidding required by Ordinance B-478 and ACA 14-58-303 is not feasible or practical, therefore:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase a 1978 Mack with reeving hoist from BFI located at Little Rock, Arkansas for a sum not to exceed \$15,000.


Section 2. The competitive bidding requirements of the City of Arkadelphia, Arkansas are hereby waived as the Board of Directors finds that the procedure is not feasible or practical due to the urgency of having a back up truck immediately.

Section 3. For the above mentioned reasons an emergency is declared to exist and therefore this ordinance is in effect immediately.
