WHEREAS the City did advertise for insurance coverage as specified by law, and


WHEREAS the City did not receive any bids from parties interested in providing this service, and

WHEREAS due to an urgent public necessity, continual insurance coverage is needed for certain real property of the City . . .


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS that the City Board authorizes the Staff to accept the negotiated offer for real property insurance coverage from Pennington Insurance Agency for continued coverage for fiscal year 1997.

DUE TO URGENT PUBLIC NECESSITY AS STATED IN THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE, THIS ACT IS DECLARED TO BE AN EMERGENCY AND THE REQUIRED READING OF THE ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE MEETINGS IS SUSPENDED, AND THE ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON PASSAGE.
