

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT ANY APPOINTEE TO A CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, ARKANSAS BOARD, COMMISSION, COMMITTEE, OR AUTHORITY, WHETHER ADVISORY OR NOT, SHALL BE A QUALIFIED ELECTOR OF THE CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, RESIDE IN AND MAINTAIN A RESIDENCE IN THE CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, AND MUST ATTEND SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75%) OF THE MEETINGS OF SAID ORGANIZATION ON ANNUAL BASIS.

WHEREAS, ACA 14-47-133 provides that every person appointed by the Board of Directors to any municipal office, employment, or position, or to membership on any board, authority, or commission shall serve for such time and shall receive such compensation as the Board may fix and determine by ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to determine qualifications to serve and continue to serve as an appointee on any board, commission, committee or authority,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. All appointees on any board, commission, committee or authority shall be qualified electors in the City of Arkadelphia and shall reside in and maintain a residence within the City of Arkadelphia at all times during the term of their appointment. In the event said appointee does not remain a qualified elector and reside in and maintain a residence within the City of Arkadelphia, the Board of Directors may declare a vacancy to exist and appoint another qualified elector to serve in said position.


SECTION 2. All appointees by the Board of Directors shall attend a minimum of seventy-five (75%) of the regular meetings of said board, commission, committee, or authority as determined on an annual basis or the Board of Directors of the City of Arkadelphia may declare a vacancy to exist and appoint a replacement.

SECTION 3. All appointees by the Board of Directors shall attend the regular meetings of said board, commission, committee or authority and in the event an appointee is absent for three consecutive regular meetings without just cause, the Board of Directors of the City of Arkadelphia may declare a vacancy to exist and appoint a replacement.
