

ORDINANCE NO. 0-00-12

**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF ORDINANCE B-478
AND ACA 14-58-303 FOR THE PURCHASING OF THE CURRENT CITY MANAGER,
BARBARA MCKELVEY'S VEHICLE, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the Arkadelphia City Board entered into an agreement with the City Manager October 19, 2000, and

WHEREAS, Item 2 in that agreement requires the city to furnish a new car in the \$15,000 to \$18,000 state purchase range for 24-hour use in lieu of a car allowance, and


WHEREAS, bid results could not offer delivery dates sooner than 100 days, there is an immediate need to comply with the provisions of the City Manager's agreement and furnish a new car in lieu of a car allowance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby find that it is not feasible nor practical to accept bids for the purchase of a new vehicle for the City Manager and hereby waives the bidding requirements, all in accordance with Ordinance B-478 and ACA 14-58-303, and authorizes the City Manager to purchase a vehicle from Gildner Ford in Arkadelphia in the price range between \$15,000 and \$18,000.

Section 2. The purchase of a new car is necessary immediately in order to furnish just compensation in lieu of a car allowance as per the terms of the October 19, 00 agreement with the City Manager, therefore an emergency is declared and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
