

ORDINANCE NO 0-01-12

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PARKS AND RECREATION
ADVISORY COMMITTEE; APPOINTING MEMBERS; ESTABLISHING
TERMS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:**

WHEREAS, The City of Arkadelphia, Arkansas has established an Ad Hoc Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee consisting of five members who were appointed to two year terms; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors desires to establish this Advisory Committee by ordinance as well as expand the number of members; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. There is hereby established a Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee consisting of seven (7) members who shall serve two year terms ending on April 15th.

Section 2. The Advisory Committee shall consist of seven (7) positions. Currently Roger Wingfield holds Position 3 and his term expires April 15, 2002. Reappointed to two year terms are Lawrence Phillips who holds Position 2, Ron Dewlen who holds Position 4 and Scott Byrd who holds Position 5 all of whose terms expire April 15, 2003.


Section 3. The Board of Directors shall appoint one person to fill the vacancy in Position 1 which term expires April 15, 2002. The Board of Directors shall appoint two parks and recreation advisory committee members being Position 6 and 7 and whose terms will expire April 15, 2002.

Section 4. The Board of Directors may appoint ex-officio members of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee to assist in certain projects.


Section 5. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee shall meet on a regular basis with the times to be established by the Advisory Committee. In addition, the Director of the Parks and Recreation Division of the City of Arkadelphia may also call special meetings. The Advisory Committee shall elect a chairman annually from its members and such other officers as may be necessary. It is the function of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee to give advice to the Parks and Recreation Director who will communicate through the City Manager to the City Board.

Section 6. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
