

**ORDINANCE NO. O-02-05**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A WATER PURCHASE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, ARKANSAS AND THE CLARK COUNTY RIVER VALLEY PUBLIC WATER FACILITIES BOARD; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Arkadelphia, Arkansas and the Clark County River Valley Public Facilities Board have heretofore had an agreement for the sale of water, and,

WHEREAS, the parties to that contract desire to amend their water purchase contract and substitute a new contract and which new contract was approved by the City of Arkadelphia, Arkansas on October 11, 2002, therefore:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, ARKANSAS:**


Section 1: The sale of water, not to exceed eleven million five hundred thousand gallons per month to the Clark County River Valley Public Water Facilities Board at a cost as set forth in Ordinance No. 0-01-11, which water rates may be amended to the City of Arkadelphia, Arkansas from time to time, is hereby approved under the terms and conditions as set forth in the water purchase contract a form copy of which is attached hereto.

Section 2: Barbara Coplen, City Manager and Rendi Currey, City Clerk, are hereby authorized to execute the water purchase contract with the Clark County River Valley Public Water Facilities Board.

Section 3: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

Section 4: In order for the purchaser to secure sufficient and adequate financing for the water distribution system built and to be built by the Clark County River Valley Public Water Facilities Board, it is necessary that this water purchase contract be approved immediately and without delay or the funds may be lost and not available, therefore an emergency is declared and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
