

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF CERTAIN
BUSINESSES BETWEEN MIDNIGHT AND 5:00 A.M. AND A PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City
of Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person within
the corporate limits of the City of Arkadelphia, Arkansas to keep
open or operate any billiard hall, pool room, bowling alley, box
ball alley, or any other similar place of amusement kept for hire.

SECTION 2. Any persons who shall violate this Ordinance
shall upon conviction be fined in a sum not less than \$25.00 nor
more than \$250.00 for each day said violation occurs. Each day
of operation of the above mentioned businesses between midnight
and 5:00 a.m. will be considered a separate violation.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances that
conflict herewith are hereby repealed and specifically repealed
is Ordinance B301 enacted May 2, 1974.

SECTION 4. It is necessary to regulate the above mentioned
places of amusement kept for hire. Therefore an emergency is
declared and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety. It shall be in full force
and effect from and after its passage.
