

ORDINANCE NO. B-401

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. B-398 (SALES TAX) AND PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, The Quorum Court of Clark County, Arkansas has requested by Resolution No. 60, that the City of Arkadelphia, Arkansas repeal Ordinance No. B-398 in order that the Quorum Court could adopt an Ordinance calling for a county-wide vote on the issue of a 1% sales tax, and;


WHEREAS, The Quorum Court of Clark County, Arkansas has passed Ordinance No. 141, setting September 15, 1981 as the date for a county-wide election.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF ARKADELPHIA, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. B-398 passed by the City of Arkadelphia Board of Directors on July 15, 1981 is hereby repealed in its entirety and the election set on August 18, 1981 is hereby cancelled.


Section 2: This Ordinance must be passed immediately in order to cancel the August 18, 1981 election. An emergency is therefore declared to exist and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
