

AN ORDINANCE TO FORMALLY ADOPT THE STATEWIDE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS FOR NEW BUILDING CONSTRUCTION WHICH BECAME EFFECTIVE ON SEPTEMBER 12, 1979; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Arkansas General Assembly has authorized the Arkansas Department of Energy to promulgate energy efficiency standards for new building construction, in accordance with Federal law; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Department of Energy promulgated and the General Assembly approved standards which became effective on September 12, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of these minimal standards will serve to significantly enhance conservation of energy in new building construction, thus lessening our dependence on foreign energy sources; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of each jurisdiction in the State issuing building permits to enforce the standards through existing inspection departments;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF Arkadelphia ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Board of Directors hereby finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Arkadelphia to formally adopt the 1979 ARKANSAS RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS FOR NEW BUILDING CONSTRUCTION, as adopted by the Arkansas Department of Energy.

SECTION 2. Any existing ordinance governing energy efficiency standards in new building construction is hereby repealed.
